

Terms and Conditions for the National Eco-Committee in the 2021/22 School Year.

Promoter

The promoter is Eco-Schools England, Keep Britain Tidy. Keep Britain Tidy is a registered Charity No. 1071737. Registered as a company limited by guarantee in England & Wales No. 3496361. Registered office at Elizabeth House, The Pier, Wigan, WN3 4EX

The National Eco-Committee application process.

1. Individuals submitting an application to be selected as member of the National Eco-Committee must be aged between 10-18, live in England and have the permission of their parent/guardian to take part (the "Applicant")
2. All applications must be submitted for consideration before Saturday 20th November 2021 at 16.30 (GMT). Any applications submitted after this time will not be accepted.
3. The Promoter will not accept applications which breach any laws in relation to content, include profanity or references which infringe the rights of third parties.
4. The Promoter will not accept responsibility for any applicants that are late or not received due to technical conditions.
5. Incomplete or duplicate applicants will not be eligible. Proof of entry is not proof of receipt.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to reject any applicants without reason or prior notice.
7. The National Eco-Committee is open to schools, individuals, and home schoolers. Applicants do not have to attend a registered Eco-School to take part.
8. By submitting your application this means you have consent from your parent/guardian to take part if chosen as a member of the National Eco-Committee.
9. By submitting your application, you are agreeing to attend at least three of the five online meetings and be available to help during the Green Careers week 18th April 2022. Failure to attend more than two online National Eco-Committee meetings will mean your place on the National Eco-Committee will be revoked and offered to another applicant.
10. Eco-Schools England is responsible for the final selection of the 25 successful applicants and has no responsibility to individual applicants, their schools, or families once the selection process is over.
11. All applicants must agree to these Terms and Conditions to be eligible for the National Eco-Committee.

Applicant Selection

1. 25 successful applicants (the "Members") will be contacted by Eco-Schools England during the week commencing 29th November 2021 using the contact details from the submitted application form.
2. Eco-Schools England will attempt to contact the Member on two occasions if Eco-Schools England is unable to contact a Member for any reason after two attempts then an alternative Member will be contacted.
3. Eco-Schools England will provide the Members with further details about participation in the National Eco-Committee and a parental/ guardian consent form and privacy notice that must be signed by a legal guardian and sent back to Eco-Schools England before the first online National Eco-Committee meeting on

Tuesday 21st December 2021. Failure to submit the signed consent form and privacy notice will mean that the Members place on the National Eco-Committee will be revoked.

4. The Member must attend the first online National Eco-Committee meeting on Tuesday 21st December 2021.
5. The Members agree for Eco-Schools England (Keep Britain Tidy), our National Eco-Committee Supporters and their partners and other Members to promote their involvement in the National Eco-Committee tasks on social media channels, websites and all other publicity materials. This includes images of the members, their name and age.
6. The result of the final 25 successful Members by Eco-Schools England is final, and no correspondence will be entered into by the Promotor.

Prize

The prize is an opportunity for the Members to join the National Eco-Committee (the "Prize"). The Prize is non-negotiable.

General

1. By entering the competition, the applicant's parent/guardian agree and are bound by these terms and conditions.
2. The Promoter reserves the right to amend these terms at any time without notice and to communicate the changes to applicant's parent/guardian or school by updating these terms on its website.
3. The Promoter shall not be liable for any failure to comply with its obligations where the failure is caused by something outside its reasonable control and shall be entitled to suspend or terminate the competition as a result.
4. The National Eco-Committee will run from November 2021 until August 2022. After this month applications for a new national Eco-Committee for the 2022/23 academic year will commence.

Eco-Schools England will provide further information to the 25 successful Members regarding their roles on the National Eco-Committee once selected and notified. These T&Cs are only in relation to the application running from Sunday 5th September 2021 until Saturday 20th November 2021 and notification period.
